Day 1 Monday, January 15: Depart USA

Independent departures from home gateways for London.

Day 2 Tuesday, January 16: Arrive in London I Orientation Tour Westminster Abbey

Arrive at London Heathrow Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim your luggage, and continue to the Arrivals Hall, where members of the group will gather. We will leave the airport as a group via private tour bus (time to be advised).*

Board our comfortable touring bus and we'll be on our way to enjoy an orientation tour of London. We'll pass the Palace of Westminster, Houses of Parliament, and Big Ben before continuing along Whitehall with its government buildings, memorial statues, and memorials. We'll pass Downing Street, Trafalgar Square, Nelson's Column, Piccadilly Circus, and the London Eye. Continue to The Mall and Buckingham Palace, where the changing of the Guard ceremony takes place daily (viewing subject to confirmation). Independent lunch.

*If your independent flights do not coordinate with the group's departure from the airport to begin the orientation tour, you will be responsible for meeting up with the group at the hotel for check-in.

Check-in at St. Giles Hotel in London.

Round trip transfers will be provided to **Westminster Abbey** to attend the 5:00 p.m. Evensong.

Session #2: 9:45 a.m.–10:45 a.m. Meeting at **Westminster Abbey** with Andrew Nethsingha (Organist and Master of the Choristers).

Theme: "Overview of the Abbey music program"

Session #3: 11:15 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Meeting at **Westminster Cathedral** with Simon Johnson (Organist and Master of Music) Theme: "Overview of the Cathedral music program"

Independent lunch.

Free time to explore London on your own.

Independent dinner.

Overnight at St. Giles London Hotel.

Day 4 Thursday, January 18: Ely and Cambridge

Breakfast at our hotel. Coach and guide available for the entire day. Depart London to visit the magnificent **Ely Cathedral** and medieval town. In 673, St. Etheldreda, Queen of Northumbria, founded a Monastery in the center of the Fens on the Isle of Ely, where she was Abbess until her death in 679. Some 400 years later, in 1081, work on the present building was begun, under the guidance of Abbott Simeon. It was completed in 1189 and the cathedral now stands as a remarkable example of Romanesque architecture.

Session #4: 10:30 a.m. Tour and meeting with Edmund Aldhouse, Director of Music Ely's Cathedral.

Independent lunch.

After lunch we'll continue to **Cambridge**, a beautiful university city. Enjoy a walking tour of this attractive city. Cambridge has been a seat of learning since the 1200's and many of the elegant buildings that adorn the city center belong to the university. During the tour, pass the oldest college, Peterhouse, founded in 1280. Possible visit to **Trinity College** if time permits.

Session #5: Continue to visit **King's College**, with its magnificent 15th Century Chapel, home of the world-famous King's College Choir. Possible greeting with Mr. Daniel Hyde (subject to confirmation).

Attend 5:30 p.m. Sung Eucharist.

Continue to St. John's College.

Session #6: 6:30 pm. Evensong at St. John's College and welcome by Christopher Gray, Music Director of St. John's College.

Independent dinner. Return to our hotel in London.

Overnight at St. Giles London Hotel.

Day 5 Friday, January 19: Kent and Canterbury Cathedral

Early breakfast at our hotel.

Coach and guide available for the entire day.

This morning, we'll leave London and drive into the beautiful countryside of **Kent**. On arrival we'll have a guided tour of **Canterbury Cathedral**, the oldest in the United Kingdom. Canterbury was the original Iron Age capital of the Kingdom of Kent, and has retained its historic importance to this day. It is now the headquarters of the Anglican church and a center for international pilgrimage. In 1170, the Archbishop of Canterbury, Thomas Becket, was murdered by King Henry II's soldiers after a bitter feud. Today you can see the site of the shrine to Becket.

Session #7 with musicians of Canterbury Cathedral.

Independent lunch. Return to London.

Session #8: 4:00 p.m.–5:30 p.m. **Brompton Oratory.** Meeting with Professor Patrick Russill, Director of Music at the London Oratory. Independent dinner.

Overnight at St. Giles London Hotel.

Day 6 Saturday, January 20: Winchester and Salisbury

Breakfast at our hotel.

Coach and guide available for the entire day.

This morning, we'll depart on a full-day excursion to ancient Winchester, capital city for Alfred the Great and later where Sir Walter Raleigh was sentenced to death. Judge Jeffreys held court here. Visit the cathedral to see the 12th- and 13th-century illuminated Bibles. Winchester Cathedral is a priceless jewel in a scarcely less precious setting. See over 900 years of history, the tombs of James Austin and Izaac Walton, and a unique collection of Chantry Chapels where William Walker, the diver, saved the cathedral in 1906.

Session #9: 10:30 a.m.–12:00 p.m. **Winchester Cathedral** tour and talk by Joshua Stephens, Winchester Cathedral Chamber Choir Director. Independent lunch.

This afternoon we'll visit the magnificent **Salisbury Cathedral**, known for having the highest spire in England. One of the four original copies of the Magna Carta signed in 1215 is here. On the Salisbury Plain, visit the mysterious **Stonehenge**. Go back in time 4,000 years to see the Avebury Stone Circles, a complex and gigantic late Neolithic henge monument, and Stonehenge, Britain's most famous prehistoric monument dating from between 3,100 and 1,100 B.C. Return to London.

Independent dinner.

Overnight at St. Giles London Hotel.

Day 7 Sunday, January 21: London

Breakfast at our hotel.

Coach and guide available for the entire day.

Late morning we'll be transferred to **Westminster Cathedral** to attend 12:00 p.m. Mass.

Independent lunch.

We'll continue to **St. Paul's Cathedral** to attend the 3:00 p.m. Evensong. Welcome by Andrew Carwood. Director of Music.

Closing banquet (location to be advised).

Overnight at St. Giles London Hotel.

Day 8 Monday, January 22: Return to the USA

Breakfast at our hotel.

One group transfer *(designated time to be advised)* will be provided to London Heathrow Airport for independent return flights home. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Pound sterling valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$500.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 65 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on tour roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements for all countries on this itinerary. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results)..

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$1,500.00 per person sharing a twin room. The Land Only package does not include any airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book all segments independently. PWT is available to assist with independent airline transportation upon request. If your flights do not coordinate with the group airport transfers, you will be responsible for meeting up with the group at the hotel for check-in. If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

INDEPENDENT AIRFARE & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests and booking independent airline transportation. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150.00 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the tour package and whose flights coordinate with the group transfer timing. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested; with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$600.00 will apply. We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus closing banquet.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, we recommend £4.00 (pound sterling) per person per day for your tour manager; £2.00 (pound sterling) per person per day for your bus driver; £1.00 (pound sterling) per person for a local guide when applicable. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave £1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and £1.00 per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. We also strongly suggest that you purchase the Cancel For Any Reason upgrade in order to cover your travel investment for unforeseen circumstances that are not covered by PWT as noted above under OF RESPONSIBILITY.
